God's Agreement with Abraham. Genesis 15 1 – 6

After all these things happened, the word of the LORD came to Abraham in a vision. God said, "Abraham, don't be afraid. I will defend you and give you a great reward."

⁵ Then God led Abraham outside and said, "Look at the sky. See the many stars. There are so many you cannot count them. Your family will be like that."

⁶ Abram believed the LORD, and because of this faith the Lord accepted him as one who has done what is right

Isaac—the Promised Son. Genesis 17 15 - 16

¹⁵ God said to Abraham, "I will give Sarai,^[a] your wife, a new name. Her new name will be Sarah.^[b] ¹⁶ I will bless her. I will give her a son, and you will be the father. "

Finally, a Baby for Sarah. Genesis 21. 1 - 3

21 The LORD came back to visit Sarah as he said he would, and he kept his promise to her. ² At exactly the time God said it would happen, Sarah became pregnant and gave birth to a son for Abraham in his old age. ³ Abraham named his son Isaac.^[c]
